JUDGES REMARKS

- This contemporary addition to the rear of a c1910 Federation era house exemplifies an accepted philosophy for extending and modernising a contributory building in a historic context, whilst retaining its key heritage values
- The addition is boldly contemporary, and split-level over two-stories, yet is not visible from the street. Conservation of the original main four room house shows a high degree of integrity internally and externally. The house retains most original character features. Articulation of the junction between the original house and the new addition is well executed.
- A highlight of the property is how the modern addition is visible subtly at first, then revealed more dramatically at the intersection of the old with the new
